

REJECT ME I DON'T LOVE IT!



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(A short no nonsense e-book message on relationships for men and women, who keep going back to old bad relationship patterns that you know are detrimental to your mental and spiritual health. No one likes rejection. This book is guaranteed to get you all back on track)

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How many of us are in the trajectory/ pathway of someone else's throw offs?

What I mean by this is that someone with a very perfect plan for their lives had so much to choose from that they could throw something off quite strategically in your pathway that they didn't want, or that did not fit in with their plans at the time? Consider a fashion designer who obtains some material that they thought would go with this season's theme. They decide to throw it out and it is then picked up by someone who needed some new clothes and who is handy with a needle and thread and made it into something quite attractive and wearable.

What if you pick that person up and that person constantly remind you that they never wanted you in the first place and they always wanted someone else? They may not verbally communicate this, but subliminally it lies dormant in their minds waiting for the right moment to manifest their true desires. It is subtly displayed in the way they overall relate to you but doesn't appear apparent until something happens.

What if you pick this person up dust them off, really help them to shine, and excel enabling them to become attractive. Then along comes the original person who did not find value in the very thing that you made into a masterpiece. They take a shining to them and experience a change in mindset. They begin to think well maybe I do like this after all. Um I think I'll have it *because I can*? In other words the dormant desires of the man/woman in question now manifests and they go back to the person who rejected them.

Does this story sound familiar? Where have you heard it or seen it before? The movie called BOOMERANG the story of Marcus the womaniser who was used and rejected by Jacklyn and picked up by Angela her assistant. Today this story would have a one in a million

chance of resulting in a happy ever after ending, as was the case in this scenario. The reason is that men need validation during this *season* of their lives. This validation comes in the format of approval from their friends, their family, their true desires and standards. When they are not affirmed by their women, they often seek it elsewhere. If it cannot be found in a woman, they seek out other men. Their affirmation criterion in this case would be out of alignment and dysfunctional (*Not biblically correct*). You see Marcus had declared his love for Angela. He had found what he loved what motivated him to do better that made him feel good about himself. In other words, his earth/reset.

Marcus, like many men in this season of their life, likes change they like an upgrade just like their cars. There are a few exceptions to the rule the ones who are disciplined tuned into their spiritual core. They view women as consumable products and want the latest model. The latest thing in fashion. They are always looking for something fresh. A change, that is, if they are restless. They want to be promoted. This is all encompassed by peer pressure and not being content with what they have. This period in their life is the most exhilarating and memorable time. They fall in love with this period and find it difficult to transition to their next season. Have you ever witnessed a 65-year-old Rock star still surrounded by groupies? I think the problem runs deeper. Essentially it is fear of the unknown and experiencing true growth in change and transition. What they desire is a natural, carnal change rather than what they should be desiring a supernatural divine change. Why? Read on.

There comes a season in a man's life when he wants to settle, he wants to rest he decides he wants to find 'the one'. It is a rare man that can take on the responsibility of finding 'the one' and a new family without wanting to bail out due to boredom or some other external factor which dictates his manhood, standard and overall belief. The Marcus's of our world encourages his woman to be

many Jacks of all trades. She must be a wife, a mother, a child bearer, the bread winner, a Barbie doll and a respectable Godly woman. His choosing to commit to her is contingent upon her being all these things. Even when she becomes all these things, she eventually wears herself out hopefully not before he has decided to retire. Otherwise, the relationship will be masked with several factors if, the man is not grounded and rooted in a solid Godly spiritual foundation. Due to the current climate this is unlikely to be possible. He may have found 'the one' but 'the one' never becomes enough. Remember he needs validation from his friends, his family, his standards and his desires. He has dealt with his standards, his family, his friends but now his true desires have changed. Desire, love is the strongest emotion the bible highlights this in *1 Corinthians 13:13* in some bible versions they replace the word love with the word charity.

More and more women are becoming independent and are tired of being suppressed by the image of the housewife who is expected to be all self-sacrificing of their careers for the sake of preventing their husbands from feeling intimidated by their success. Even if they find a husband who is 'okay' with their success, the challenge then becomes competitiveness within the household. If the partner is not averse to being kept by a woman something is lost in his self-worth and therefore, he will ultimately exhibit repressed anger and resentment in his behaviour in some manner. Not to mention the loss of respect that his partner would secretly be harbouring for him. If on the other hand both partners are engaged in high profile careers, for the competitiveness to be healthy their environment requires a medium that promotes constant self-growth, through revaluation and honest communication.

What do you do to avoid this situation?

Seek out God's plan for your life and stick to it relentlessly. Only then will you avoid becoming the vulnerable prey in this scenario. If you find yourself in this situation, you won't take the bait. Angela was a very professional woman in her own right, but she never had a real drive or focus to market herself in the way she needed to be marketed. She required a catalyst a red-hot poker, that poker was Marcus. Angela never had the killer instinct in business but had a heart of gold. She never lost her heart of gold even when she stepped out in faith, sacrificing the thing she loved and found solace in, working with children increasing their creative ability through art. As a result, she was elevated to high levels of achievement and responsibility in her career. Her posture changed she was more focused, more refined more defined, more decisive and more determined. She just shifted her priorities and focused like a magnifying glass on the key things that were necessary to get her to her destination. She took her focus off Marcus and onto the things that God intended her to be. She began to take care of herself. To be the best person she could be to serve better. Her rejection by Marcus caused her to realise how much she depended on a man for validation and support and not realise that she could have found this validation by tapping into the resources God had provided. Sometimes it is not our careers that God has called us to but something that will not only catapult us out of our comfort zones it will stretch us far beyond realms any natural position would.

Marcus rejecting Angela forced her to tap into another dimension necessary for her elevation. This is like a motor vehicle with special enhanced features built within it that are only operative when the car encounters specific conditions. The Special features do not come into play until they are required. It was almost like a role reversal for Angela whereby she had to become the strong one the provider of the household the leader. She realised she had to

protect her heart. The bible tells us to protect our heart with all diligence *Prov. 4:23*. I believe that is a message for someone. I think that someone was me. I am kind of guessing that someone is you also. What am I really getting at?

The Above Scenario is just a metaphor for explaining the fundamental basis for all relationships. People gravitate to what or whom they love/like the most. Knowing that there are several contingencies which dictate the perfect match or connection removes our feelings about rejection. This is in the natural but in the supernatural we also see there are also contingencies those contingencies are not predictable or quantifiable they are dynamic and reliant upon God's eternal plan. Knowing this we cannot possibly continue to beat ourselves up or blame ourselves once very natural contingency has been removed.

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
